

1. General political conditions and contract policies:

Perception of quality in teaching and studies at FUB

- Percentage of students from underprivileged /disadvantaged social groups like poor or migrant students distant to higher education
- Percentage of students that leave university early or change their subject
- Range of measures to integrate and consult students
- Rates of students successfully finished their studies within regular study time
- Average duration of study time
- Quality of gained competencies and knowledge
- Success in implementing gender and diversity measures



1. General political conditions and contract policies:

Main "interest groups" of study and teaching at university:

- Students and those interested to study
- Labour market and employers
- Teaching faculty
- State



1. General political conditions and contract policies

Five global criteria of state policy driven benefit and punishment system:

- 1. Amount of research projects in terms of research money acquired
- 2. Number of students successfully finishing in regular study time (+2 semester)
- 3. Number of foreign researchers attracted to university (Humboldt scholarships)
- 4. Number of successful doctoral students/ number of habilitations,



1. General political conditions and contract policies

5. Respecting *diversity issues*: Raise number of female professors in faculties min. up to 20% overall departments, 38% female professors among the newly employed in last five years, raise number of female students attracted to MINT faculties as well as number of foreign students / with migrant background attracted and support them so that they succeed at university

3.2 Regular Instruments und Processes for improvement of quality of studies and teaching

3.2.8. Second quality pact:

Overall mentoring-programs

Orientation-weeks for first-semester-students prior to begin of study accompanied by mentors one week prior of the regular begin of all studies.

All faculties establish central offices - with broad and reliable opening hours - for study and examination, in order to secure all processes of competent working on all questions on studies and examination.

Didactic concepts for studies are to be developed that work against reproduction of gender-stereotypes in study and teaching.



3.2 Instruments und Processes for regular improvement of quality of studies and teaching

3.2.9. Performance-based budget negotiations on state level

For internal distribution of financial resources for studies and teaching the following indicators and criteria are set by the state (50% of the budget):

Extent of utilization of study places (10%)

Number of students successfully finished their studies (50 %)

Number of students finishing within regular study time (30 %)

Number /portion of foreign students (10 %)

TQM-Group: Staff for quality assurance to support decisions of the presidency, who execute the transformation of the TQM (Total-quality management-system)
