PROGRAMME CATALOGUE

The *Programme Catalogue* is a hierarchical classification system of university degrees and higher qualifications based on their disciplinary proximity. It includes bachelor's degrees, master's degrees, doctorates, and higher artistic education programmes.

The catalogue enables the generation of indicators for each defined aggregation level, allowing for multilevel analyses that serve as a basis for the design of policies or initiatives aimed at improving quality.

Purpose

The *Programme Catalogue* serves multiple functions:

- > It facilitates **traceability** by obtaining historical data on degree programmes and disciplines, as neither a change of name nor a change in the official code of a programme results in a change of code in the catalogue. For example, a post-Bologna degree in Law has the same catalogue code number as a pre-Bologna degree in Law.
- > It **groups** similar degree programmes, enabling the indicators of a programme to be easily compared with those of similar programmes (benchmarks).
- > It provides **results** synthesised according to different levels (subfield, expanded subfield, etc.).
- > **Integrate information** from sources of different nature and levels of aggregation, whether from evaluation processes, academic indicators provided by UNEIX, and/or survey results.
- > It provides for **multilevel analysis** (at bachelor, master's and doctorate level) according to subject area and subject. For example, in the case of Economics, according to the different educational levels (bachelor, master's and doctorate).

Structure

The catalogue has four levels of aggregation, from broadest to narrowest: field, expanded subfield, detailed subfield and discipline. This classification provides a system that fulfils the needs and requirements of the various different stakeholder groups, including students, prospective students, academic managers and study programme coordinators, university officials, researchers, government authorities and quality assurance reviewers.

Updates

The *Programme Catalogue* is reviewed and updated periodically to meet the needs of stakeholders and to adapt to the evolving realities of the university system.
