- > The purpose of this survey is to ask employers about the education of recent graduates **grouped by university degree**. As such, this survey classifies the degrees using the most detailed grouping level of AQU Catalunya's <u>programme catalogue</u> (seven-digit education code).

- 8. *The Catalan university system has recently increased the number of official degree programmes on offer that differ from the traditional ones, both in terms of duration and content. Do you think these new approaches could be a valuable recruitment factor for your company?
 - (1) Double university degree (vs. a degree): Yes/No/Don't know
 - A double degree offers the possibility of studying two different degrees simultaneously and of obtaining both diplomas upon completion, in less time than required if they were studied separately.
 - (2) Dual university degree (vs. a degree): Yes/No/Don't know
 A dual university degree combines learning in an institution and education in a university.
 - (3) Joint university degree with one or more international universities (vs. degrees from a single Catalan university): Yes/No/Don't know
 - The joint degree aims to create a unique curriculum from two or more universities to obtain a single diploma certificate, issued by all participating universities, or a certificate from each of the universities (multiple diploma certificate), depending on the terms of the agreement.
